Background

Clovis Community Medical Center's \$300 million expansion and renovation has nearly doubled the hospital's capacity to 208 private rooms – making Clovis Community the first full-service hospital in the area with all-private rooms.

Generous donor-investor support has also made possible the H. Marcus Radin Conference Center at Clovis Community. Not originally planned as part of the hospital's expansion, the Radin Center was made possible by more than \$6 million in philanthropic gifts.

The conference center is located next to the parking structure and hospital's main entrance. It helps meet the education needs of physicians and employees through continuing employee and physician education and training, medical staff meetings and a wide range of clinical educational conferences, including those with nationally recognized lecturers.

Clovis Community also launched a monthly public education lecture series, "HealthQuest," at the conference center in the spring of 2014.

- 216-seat auditorium
- 100-seat foyer with monitors displaying auditorium screen presentations. Foyer also may serve as dining space and/or auditorium overflow
- 50-seat conference room
- 2 computer training rooms
- 2 smaller conference rooms
- Food service area for catering needs
- Administrative space
