The candidate should be interested in pursuing a career in General Dentistry.

**The externship is open to 3rd and 4th year dental students attending an accredited U.S. Dental School.** Length of externship is one week mandatory; two preferably if possible. (See bottom of Home page for link to lodging facilities near us). Please provide the following:

1. Letter of intent with dates of proposed clerkship
2. Letter of recommendation from dental staff
3. Current copy of CV
4. 2 x 2 color photo
5. Current copy of grades and CPR
6. Proof of insurance liability during your time with us
7. TB results, Hepatitis, and MMR.
8. Proof of health coverage during your time with us (and protocol given to you should you incur an incident during assisting and/or doing hands-on)
