

# Clovis Community Medical Center

## Background

Clovis Community Medical Center has grown in scope and reputation since its establishment in 1965 as the 35-bed, acute-care Clovis Memorial Hospital located at DeWitt and Sierra Avenues in Clovis, California. In 1979, the hospital merged with then-Fresno Community Hospital, and in 1982 was renamed Clovis Community Hospital.

In 1988, Clovis Community Hospital opened at its current location on the northeast corner of Herndon and Temperance Avenues on a 120-acre campus. Known today as Clovis Community Medical Center, and one of Community Medical Centers' four inpatient hospitals, it's often Valley residents' first choice for women's services, advanced surgeries and comprehensive care.

### Hospital features and services

To help meet the Central Valley's continued growth in population, in fall 2022, Clovis Community's expansion and renovation project increased inpatient bed capacity to 352 all-private rooms.

Patients have increased access to comprehensive care at Clovis Community for services such as emergency, imaging and surgical care, along with state-of-the-art technology and support services available including laboratory and inpatient pharmacy.

Technological advancements enhance the patient experience with processes for in-person and online scheduling, registering and navigating the hospital and campus buildings. Many primary care and specialty physician offices are located on the medical campus, offering convenient access to care for patients.

### Outpatient Care Center

Clovis Community's Outpatient Care Center is one of the busiest outpatient surgery centers in the area, performing an average of 900 outpatient surgeries per month in its nine operating rooms. A dedicated endoscopy center opened in 2009, adding a six-bay pre-operative area, four procedure rooms, a private family conference space and private patient exit with a reserved patient pick-up area.

The Marjorie E. Radin Breast Care Center meets the unique needs of patients while setting a new standard of care for breast health through advanced technology and a multidisciplinary approach. A holistic approach to breast care encourages patients to take charge of their health, with screening mammography used as an effective tool in the early detection of breast cancer.

## Heart & Lung Institute

The Heart & Lung Institute at Clovis Community bridges the systemwide strengths of Community’s three acute care hospitals and takes cardiothoracic and pulmonary care to new levels. At Clovis Community, the latest surgical and procedural additions include 3 cath labs, 2 cardiac operating rooms and 1 advanced hybrid operating room.

The teams at each acute care hospital are nationally recognized for their strides in heart care, through advanced technology and compassionate treatment for Valley patients. As the program continues to evolve across the Community system, Valley residents have even greater access to comprehensive cardiac and lung care.
