Our recycled water usage assists our city in meeting its conservation goals by reducing the demand for potable (drinkable) water

If not used by partners like us, it would be sent to percolation ponds for evaporation or routed to creeks and canals



Our recycled water is used for landscape irrigation, and cannot be used for human consumption or on agricultural crops
