Fresno Heart & Surgical Hospital opened in north Fresno in 2003 as the Fresno Heart Hospital, solely providing cardiovascular surgery and procedures. It was initially designed to treat patients with cardiac and vascular needs. In 2006, services expanded to include bariatric and general surgery. Consistent with its mission to provide exceptional care, the hospital expanded to also include minimally invasive surgery.

Fresno Heart & Surgical Hospital expanded again in 2008 to add two specialty high-tech operating rooms and support service areas. The Advanced Diagnostic Testing Center, which offers outpatient laboratory, imaging and endoscopy services that support the hospital, was opened nearby in 2012. The hospital's conference and education center is located on its first floor.

Today, Fresno Heart & Surgical Hospital is a 48-bed specialty hospital known for its luxurious accommodations, excellent patient experience and top accolades for cardiac, vascular and bariatric surgery services. The hospital also offers restaurant-quality cuisine that caters to individual patient needs and tastes.
